How it Works



CONNECT

Patient calls a dedicated toll-free number or logs on to their member portal to schedule a consultation with a physician who is licensed in their state.



TRIAGE

Member speaks to a Care Coordinator who will triage and update the patient's Electronic Health Record(EHR) along with all symptoms.



CONSULT

Member consults with Physician who recommends a treatment plan. If a prescription is necessary, it will be sent to the pharmacy of your choice.



CARE CONTINUITY

The doctor will update the member's EHR immediately after the consultation. The patient has 24/7 secure access to their member portal.







How much will the doctor consultation cost?

There is no cost for members to request or receive a consultation. The only cost is the monthly program access fee of \$19.95

Do I talk to "real doctors"?

Yes. Members only talk to actual doctors who are state-licensed family practitioners, primary care physicians, internists and pediatricians. When members request a consult, they will be connected with a doctor licensed and practicing in their state.

Is 24/7 Physician On Call for emergency situations?

24/7 Physician On Call is only for non-emergency medical issues. Members should not use it if they are experiencing a medical emergency. Please dial 911 if you are having a medical emergency. 24/7 Physician On Call is also not intended to replace a member's primary care physician.

What type of doctor or specialist can I speak with?

Members can talk to a doctor directly. Our doctors are licensed in internal medicine, family medicine and pediatrics. A doctor may also provide guidance on the type of specialist a member should see.

Can I use it for my family?

The primary member and up to 6 immediate family members or household members will have access to consultations.

Can I get a prescription?

A prescription is not guaranteed. It is up to the doctor to recommend the best treatment. Doctors will submit your prescription directly to the pharmacy of the member's choice. Doctors will never issue prescriptions for substances controlled by the DEA and certain other drugs which may be harmful because of their potential for abuse. These include, but are not limited to, antidepressant drugs such as Cymbalta, Prozac, Percocet, Oxycodone and Zoloft. Non-therapeutic drugs such as Viagra and Cialis are not prescribed by network doctors.

How are prescriptions sent to the pharmacy?

24/7 Physician On Call does not dispense prescription drugs. If the doctor prescribes medication, it is submitted electronically or by phone to the pharmacy of the member's choice.

Is my electronic health record kept private?

Health records are kept private and secure in order to protect members' personal information. Only members can determine who can see the Information in their records.

Can I be turned down for a pre-existing condition?

No, members are not turned away because of pre-existing conditions. 24/7 Physician On Call is not insurance.

Can I get a consultation outside of the United States?

No. Consultations are not available outside of the United States.

Do I need to sign a Contract?

No, 24/7 Physician On Call offers this service on a month-to-month basis. As a customer you have the ability to cancel at any time.

Is 24/7 Physician On Call HIPAA Compliant?

Yes. 24/7 Physician On Call has developed all the system technologies, including the interfaces to the technology systems provided by third party providers. 24/7 Physician On Call manages the data security for this site. All data is stored in encrypted format that meets standards defined by HIPAA (Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act). All data transfer is executed using similar standards that meet or exceed HIPAA, and no data is transferred

What is Rx-Valet?

Rx-Valet is a marketing company that has partnered with a Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) or several PBM's to generate traffic (sales). The PBM's negotiate discounts with pharmacies and earn a transaction fee in exchange for sending the pharmacy customers.

Why do I need Rx-Valet?

Prescription drug prices are not regulated. The cost of a prescription may differ by more than \$100 between pharmacies across the street from each other!. Insurance isn't helping like it used to. In the past 10 years, insurance companies have passed 25-80% more of the cost of drugs onto patients.

What are Rx-Valet coupons?

Rx Valet coupons will help you pay less than the cash price for your prescription. They're free to use and are accepted at virtually every U.S. pharmacy. Your pharmacist will know how to enter the codes on the coupon to pull up the lowest discount available.
